- Flexible Secure Server Options that meet the needs of your Organization, including Cloud Hosted or Customer Hosted



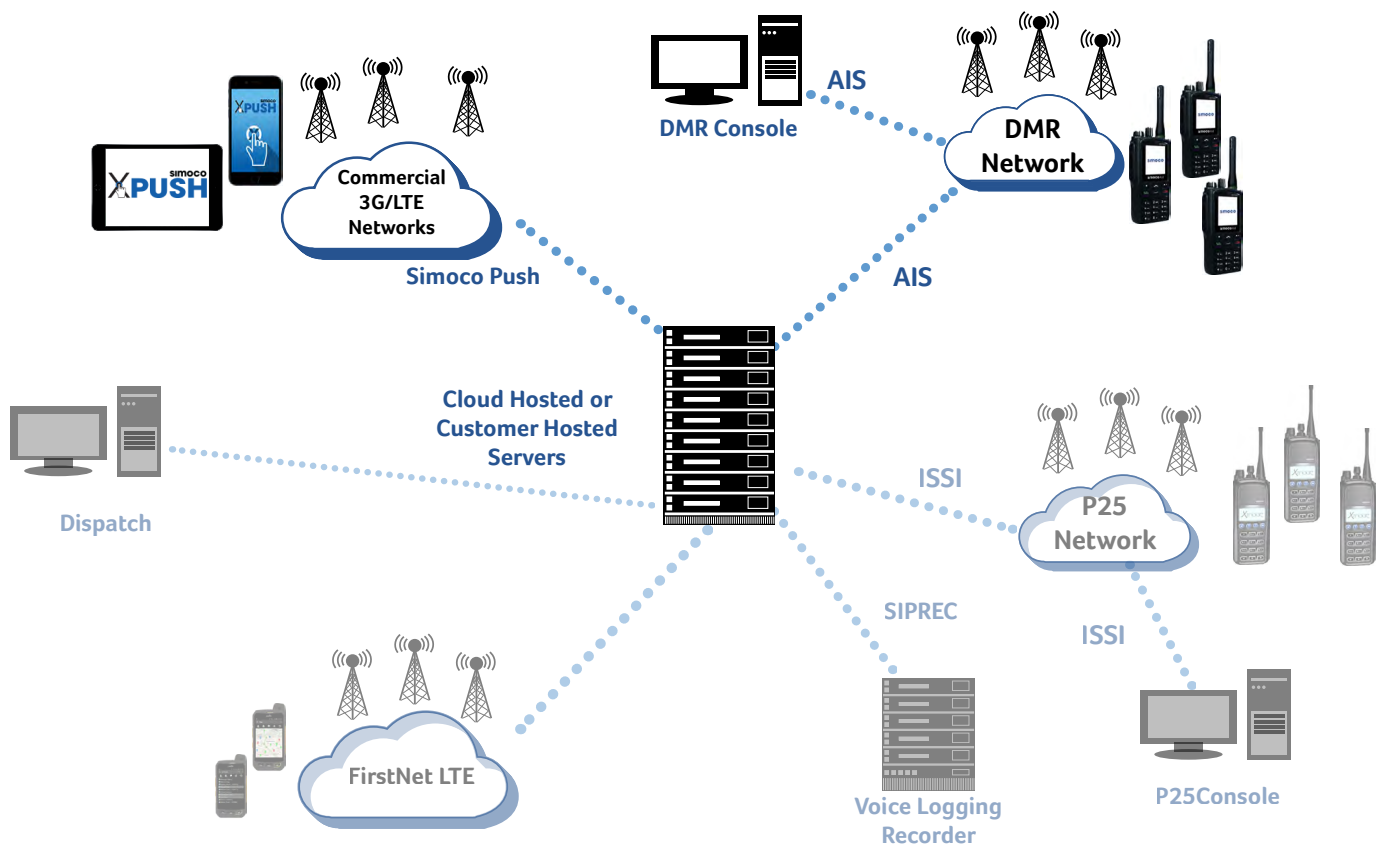
